In each Championship points are awarded to the top 32 anglers competing, for the current and past 4 years (5 years total). eg. 1-100, 2-86.1, 3-74.1, 4-63.8, 5-54.9, 6-47.2, 7-40.7, 8-35.0, 9-30.1, 10-25.9, 11-22.3, 12-19.2, 13-16.5, 14-14.2, 15-12.2, 16-10.5, 17-9.1, 18-7.8, 19-6.6, 20-5.8, 21-5.0, 22-4.3, 23-3.7, 24-3.2, 25-2.7, 26-2.4, 27-2.0, 28-1.7, 29-1.5, 30-1.3, 31-1.1, 32-1.0
