

AT TEFF Loch-style Qualifier
Carsington Water
Sunday 23rd June



There was a full house at Carsington Water on Sunday 23rd June as 32 anglers competed in the AT TEFF qualifier for a place in the Final at Chew Valley in September.

274 trout were caught for a rod average of just over eight fish.

First place was taken by Dom Sheratte who caught 21 trout. Dom fished the East bank, drifting across Fish Tail Creek, targeting rising fish with two Blobs on a Fast Glass line. He switched to dries in the afternoon when takes dried up, catching on a Black Midas. Later in the day he changed to a Di3 Sweep and a single Blob to take his final few fish.

Second place went to Sam Bailey with 20 fish, and third went to Iain Barr with 18 fish. The top eight anglers will fish the final at Chew.
