"4. When half day qualifiers are run, the morning and afternoon qualifiers shall be scored and placed separately and then combined to enable an overall placed listing to be compiled.

5. To combine the results the competitor scoring the largest number of fish points (morning or afternoon session) will be the overall winner, with the competitor scoring the largest number of fish points in the other session being placed second. Third and fourth overall places will be calculated between the two second placed competitors in both sessions on a percentage basis of the total fish points score in each respective session. The same method will be used to decide between the two third placed competitors to calculate the fifth and sixth overall places, and so on.")
