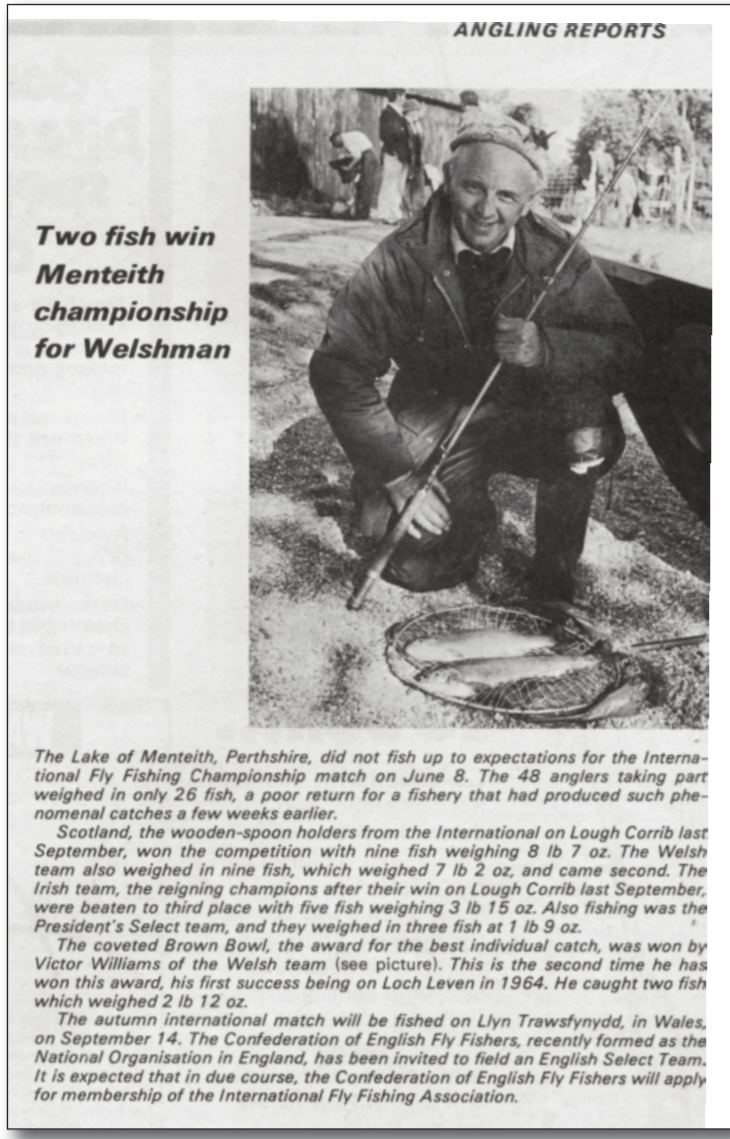

Scots win the International

In one of the best international fly-fishing matches in the last decade Scotland were worthy winners when they caught 67 fish weighing 67 lb 3½ oz, at Llyn Trawsfynydd, Merionethshire, on September 14. This was a wonderful overall team performance, with outstanding catches by Mike McKinnell and Jimmy Wilson, each with 12 fish. Thus, Scotland, with a victory at Menteth in the spring, completed a double for the first time.

The Welsh team came second with 54 fish weighing 59 lb 11 oz. They had the man of the match in Colin Hughes, of Machynlleth, whose basket of 12 fish weighed 13 lb 1½ oz, winning him the coveted Brown Bowl. His best fish weighed 3 lb 10 oz (picture facing).

The Irish team, despite a monster of over 4 lb by their team manager, Lieutenant-Colonel M. T. Moylett, were in third place with 22 fish weighing 24 lb 4½ oz.

An English-select team, re-appearing on the international scene after a regrettable absence of two years, had 19 fish weighing 17 lb 9 oz. In their team they had the youngest competitor in Mr S. Pope, of Bristol, and he caught five fish weighing 4 lb 15½ oz, the best bag in the English-select team.
